R.A. 7160

The Local Government Code of the Philippines

SEC. 107. Composition of Local Development Councils. (a) The barangay development council shall be composed of the following members:

- (1) Members of the sangguniang barangay;
- (2) Representatives of non-governmental organizations operating in the barangay, who shall constitute not less than one fourth (1/4) of the members of the . . . council;
- (3) A representative of the congressman.

R.A. 7160

The Local Government Code of the Philippines

SEC. 107 (d) The local development councils may call upon any local official concerned or any official of national agencies or offices in the local government unit to assist in the formulation of their respective development plans and public investment programs.

The call to Social Transformation starts with the Filipino Family and their Political Education.



The Barangay is a corporation

- All members of a barangay are the stockholders of the barangay
- The Barangay has powers granted by RA 7160 to promote and provide its stockholders with basic services.
- Barangay Leaders are responsible for designing a comprehensive multisectoral development plan for the benefit of all its constituents/members.



Each voting member thru its community leaders, must participate in the planning, monitoring and controlling of the Barangay's programs, income & expenses.



EDUCATING THE BARANGAY MEMBERS

- GBM volunteers meet community leaders regularly to give educational orientation on the Local Government Code and the responsibilities of Barangay Officials to improve the quality of life of barangay members.
- This educational initiative can be achieved by distributing the book “EMPOWERING FILIPINOS AND THEIR COMMUNITY”
